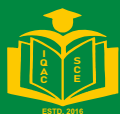

ABOUT JAMSHEDPUR

Jamshedpur holds the honor of being the first well planned Industrial city of India, founded and named after Jamshedji Nusserwanji Tata. Surrounded by Dalma hills, Jamshedpur is bordered by Swarnrekha and Kharkai river in the North and West of the city. The town is mainly known for its steel factories and also about the various mines located nearby.

As compared to the best of our country Jamshedpur holds high literacy rate having more than 183 schools and above 15 colleges catering the educational needs of over 30,000 children. The city is known for its well maintained and developed township controlled mainly by TATA company.

TRANSPORTATION

AIR : The city's airport is located at Sonari, however the air movement is done mainly by two airports that is Ranchi and Kolkata.
